## Participants will:

- Explore current evidence informed research and information about autism and better understand the impact on a young person's learning and participation
- Reflect on the experiences of young people on the autism spectrum and their family members
- Investigate the processes and strategies that strengthen effective whole school change
- Plan and implement strategies that support the young person to maximise learning in the school and home environment



## **Program Steps:**

01

- Meet with Positive Partnerships staff member to confirm involvement and discuss expectations and commitment
- Form a school Action Team (up to 5 staff) to coordinate the program and lead change within the school
- Whole staff complete one online learning module
- Whole staff complete a survey to identify school strengths and priority areas

02

 Action Team participate in a planning day to review survey data. Work with Positive Partnerships staff to plan content delivery of 2-day whole staff professional learning

03

- Whole staff participate in two face to face workshop days
- Action Team supports colleagues' learning at the workshop and the development of plans with clear goals and actions based on survey data

04

- Post-workshop, whole staff complete a minimum of two online learning activities
- Whole staff participate in the implementation of plans

05

 Action Team supports colleagues to implement plans and submit their reflections to Positive Partnerships
